




Child In-Person Participation Algorithm

Keep Child with SYMPTOMS of COVID-19 at home:		Keep Child at Home Until Following Criteria Met:										
<p>One of the following¹:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fever (100.4°F or higher) New or worsened cough Loss of taste or smell Sore throat New or worsened nasal congestion or runny nose <p>OR</p> <p>Two or more of the following¹:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Headache Body aches New or worsened fatigue Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea <p><small>¹ Excludes symptoms attributable to an alternative diagnosis. Keep Child with EXPOSURE to COVID-19 at home:		Keep Child at Home Until Following Criteria Met:
<p>Exposure is determined by the local public health department.</p> <p><i>Close contact is defined as someone who was within 6 feet of a person either laboratory confirmed or clinically diagnosed with COVID-19 for at least 15 minutes.</i></p>	 	<p>Obtain COVID-19 viral test.</p> <p>Child must be cleared by the local public health department.</p> <p>Quarantine and monitor for symptoms².</p> <p><small>² The local health department will assist schools and child care centers in determining which asymptomatic children may require testing when an entire cohort, classroom or team has been exposed.</small></p>

† Counties under Level 1 Health Advisory should follow guidance by the local public health department.
